Exhibition Submission Guidelines

Proposals for exhibitions in the Smith Gallery at Grinnell College are welcomed from Grinnell art majors and students currently enrolled in a studio art course. Proposals can be for individual or group shows. Proposals are submitted via email to Donna Stack: stackdon@grinnell.edu and must be received by December 1st for Spring 2010. Proposals will be accepted on a rolling basis for Fall 2009, until all slots are filled.

Exhibition proposals should include the following:

- 300 word project description. This document should include as much information as possible about the physical properties of the work. Please also indicate any special equipment or installation requirements.
- 3 to 5 JPG images of previous work. These images should relate closely to the work that you will install in the gallery. If you are creating new work, or a site specific installation, please include supplemental drawings or photographs. JPG images should be no larger than 1 MB. Please also note that the committee will judge your work by the quality of your images.
- A list of studio art courses taken, other exhibitions you have participated in, and other relevant studio experience.
- The name of the studio faculty member you have discussed this exhibition with.

If your work is selected for exhibition you will be sent a contract by email with exhibition dates, and your responsibilities for maintenance of the space and publicity of the event. The Department of Art looks forward to your application.
