

Biotechnology: Bountiful Harvest or Bitter Harvest?

Format for Tutorial Papers

General Comments

- Papers must be typewritten or produced on a laser printer.
- All text must be double-spaced with 1 inch margins on all sides.
- Pages must be arranged in the correct sequence and numbered.
- Your paper should have a title page with your name, the date, and the title of your paper.
- The entire paper **must be stapled together when turned in** (no paper clips). Note: I do not carry a stapler with me!
- **Proof read your paper!** Good grammar, spelling and punctuation are essential. If I encounter as many as 4 typographical or spelling errors before reaching the end of your paper, it will be returned to you for correction before it is evaluated further.

References

Any books, articles or other sources that you cite in your paper should be listed in the Works Cited section at the end of the paper. List only the papers or other publications that were *directly referred to* in your paper. The listings should be in alphabetical order (by the last names of the first authors). Although a variety of formats are used by different publishers, I would like you to use the Modern Language Association (MLA) Formatting and Style Guide which can be found at the following web site:

At the bottom of its first page you can find a menu that will direct you to specific topics regarding ways to cite any type of source. The MLA format is widely used in academic circles and will provide you with a common set of guidelines to use in this course. See me if you have any questions along the way.
