

Curriculum Committee Minutes
December 4, 2007

1. The minutes of the meeting of 11/20/07 were approved.
2. New Course Approval: HIS-262: Consideration of 262 was tabled. There were 2 reasons. The first is that the course form indicated that the course could be repeated for credit. The committee did not understand why it would be allowed to repeat a non-variable content course for credit. The second is probably more complex. That issue is the one about course numbers. The faculty approved description of course numbers is below. The course submitted does not comply as the proposal is for a 200 level course but the course has no pre-requisites. The Dean agreed to seek answers for these two question from the department.
3. The committee conducted a final review of the proposal on MAPs and the Support for Independent Study
4. The committee tabled the two issue concerning Internships until spring.
5. The committee will review the rules governing Independent Majors in the spring.
