

CALL FOR PAPERS

The 74th Annual Meeting of the Midwest Economics Association will be held March 19-21, 2010 just north of Chicago at the Hotel Orrington, Evanston, IL. The MEA invites papers and organized sessions in all areas of economics — theoretical, quantitative, institutional, or policy oriented. If you would like to submit a paper for consideration, please complete the paper submission form located on the MEA website at <http://web.grinnell.edu/mea>. If you are uncomfortable paying on-line through a secure server, then complete the form without credit information and send your check to the Midwest Economics Association, 416 Windmill Drive, Kaukauna, WI 54130.

If you would like to organize a session please send an e-mail to MEA president, Professor Derek Neal at mea@grinnell.edu with the topic and proposed participants. Sessions are one hour and 45 minutes long and include a chair; three or four papers; and three to four discussants. Panel discussions, in which a moderator and three or more panelists discuss a topic of current interest, provide an alternative that can also be useful.

Deadline for abstract submissions is October 16, 2009. Submission fees for MEA members are \$25 per paper and \$20 for member graduate students.* Membership dues are \$20 for the 2009-10 year and may be paid with the paper fee. If you decline to join the MEA at this time, the submission fee is \$50 per paper.
