## 2011-2012 Courses: Updated with NEW Spring 2012 Information

**Please note:** Beginning in the fall of 2009, a Major in Gender, Women's, and Sexuality Studies (GWSS) became available to Grinnell students; this Major will ultimately replace the Concentration in GWS. Students who matriculated in 2007 or 2008 may continue to declare the GWS Concentration in academic year 2011-12.

### The Major in Gender, Women's, and Sexuality Studies requires the following:

- 1) Introduction to Gender, Women's, and Sexuality Studies (GWS 111)
- 2) Theory and Methodology in Gender, Women's, and Sexuality Studies (GWS 249)
- 3) Five courses (20 credits) from *at least three* of the four thematic rubrics listed below:
  - A. Sexuality and Queer Studies
  - B. Cross-Cultural and Transnational Approaches
  - C. Literary and Artistic Criticism
  - D. Political/Philosophical/Historical/Social Analyses
- 4) At least *two* of these five courses (or 8 credits) must be at the 300-level
- 5) Senior Seminar in Gender, Women's, and Sexuality Studies (GWS 495)
